

Campsite Maintenance Know-How

Campsite accessories

Each campsite should have the following accessories:

- Bannister brush.
- Dustpan – metal is recommended, because one use is to assist with clearing out the fire pit. Metal pans are more robust to this task!
- Broom – to sweep the bed platforms. Soft bristles and a long shaft are best. Metal (or plastic) shafts are recommended; wooden shafts have been known to be used as firewood.
- Leaf rake – with a non-wooden shaft, for the same reason.
- A box for the log book, red register, some copies of Bibbulmun News and brochures. It only needs to be big enough to fit these items, i.e. fairly shallow. We want to dissuade walkers from leaving food/equipment in the box. Refer to the factsheet **Book boxes** for more information.
- A large box for overnight storage of food is not a standard campsite accessory. Refer to the factsheet **Food protection boxes** for more information.

You may replace broken or worn-out accessories at your campsite... walkers will appreciate it!

Please try to purchase reasonably good quality items, so they last as long as possible, especially for any plastic. This is the best way to reduce plastic in the environment and as waste.
